With Lynn Freeman Olson and Louise Bianchi, he co-authored the *Music Pathways* series. His editions of Bach, Beethoven, and Grieg are thoughtfully prepared and carefully researched.

Mr. Blickenstaff is Board President of the Frances Clark Center for Keyboard Pedagogy and serves on the executive planning committee for the National Conference on Keyboard Pedagogy. He teaches at the New School for Music Study in Kingston, NJ, and in his home studio in the greater Philadelphia area.
